In 1998, Hollis was appointed product line manager, Corning Asahi Video Components, where he was responsible for leading Corning's TV Frit, Gun mount, Neck, and Neck Tubing business. In 1999, Fall Brook's Lighting and Electronic Materials businesses were added to his responsibility.

In 2001, Hollis joined Specialty Materials' Photonic Materials business as product line manager, Micro Lens, and was appointed commercial director, Specialty Materials, in 2003.

In 2007, Hollis was named program manager, Project Mercury, where he led the adoption of Corning Gorilla Glass into Apple Incorporated's first iPhone and iPod Touch devices. After the successful launch at Apple, Gorilla won broader market adoption across a number of industry leading consumer electronics device makers.
