RECOMMENDED DETERMINATION ON REMEDY AND BOND**

On this date, I issued the final initial determination in this matter. 19 C.F.R. §§ 210.10(b), 210.42(a)(1)(i). As explained in that determination, I found that there is a violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain glass substrates for liquid crystal displays, products containing the same, and methods for manufacturing the same based on infringement of U.S. Patent Nos. 8,642,491 and 8,640,498.
