Dear Trusted Suppliers,

In 2023, Corning's <u>science-based GHG emissions reduction targets were approved by the Science Based Target initiative</u>. Our suppliers will be critical in helping us achieve these targets.

Therefore, we will be including new GHG emissions requirements in our Supplier Code of Conduct and future supplier contracts. In 2024 we are requiring our suppliers to disclose scope 1, 2 and 3 greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions data through the upcoming CDP Supply Chain disclosure cycle. More details about the requirements will be provided in a secondary email.

Suppliers are also required to complete additional decarbonization actions to reduce their carbon footprint. These actions support the reduction of Corning publicly stated goals of a scope 3 reduction by 2028. Please review the supporting documents attached to this email for more information.

Important Call to Action

Please prepare to complete the CDP Climate Change and Water Questionnaire and submit this information to Corning by **Sept 18**th, **2024**, through CDP's Online Response System (ORS). The most appropriate person to complete this task is typically someone responsible for environmental management and disclosure (e.g., someone in ESG, environmental sustainability, facilities management, or community affairs). If you are not the appropriate person, please reply to gsmsustainability@corning.com with the appropriate contact.

The CDP Questionnaires ask you to report information such as: your risks and opportunities associated with climate change and water, your emissions, your water withdrawals, details on your emissions and water management strategy including targets and actions you've taken to reduce your emissions and water impact. We will use the information suppliers report through CDP to calculate our scope 3 emissions, track progress against our science-based targets, and identify areas for collaboration and improvement.

We recognize that there are many stages of sustainability maturity, and we are here to support you in this journey. In the coming months, more information about supplier specific requirements beyond reporting to CDP will be communicated. Additionally, we will be offering several training webinars on the key sustainability topics outlined below. More information about the webinars will be shared in a secondary email.
